The Geneva meeting in June will be the first such occasion for the commonwealth trade unionists to discuss the outcome of the 2007 Commonwealth People's Forum in Kampala in November 2007. The 2007 Commonwealth People's Forum had included in their CPF communiqué all our demands made in the CTUG Statement.
