- Complements ODA ODA will remain the cornerstone of donor accountability (no backing away from existing commitments!).
- Covers the totality of official resources in support of sustainable development, regardless of the types of instruments and terms.
- Calculated on gross terms, but net flows would also be collected (needed for the recipients' perspective).
- Amounts mobilised by official action would be reported separately.

Coverage for key thematic areas

TOSD could:

Climate change

capture the totality of public support to climate / environment.

Peace and security

cover a broader range of peace and security expenditures.

Trade and Exports

potentially include official export credits if funding addresses the objective of sustainable development.

Multilateral channels of delivery

capture full contributions to norm-setting multilateral agencies.
