### **SDG 1:** eradicate poverty

- 1. Invest in decent and climate-friendly jobs + formalization
- 2. Extend social protection
- 3. minimum living wages and equal pay
- 4. Labour protection floor
- 5. Social services linked to basic needs (multidimensional poverty)
- 6. Advance gender equality, equality and non-discrimination
- 7. institutionalized social dialogue
- 8. progressive taxation systems at the country level
- 9. Role of trade unions in the fight against poverty



### SDG 2: zero hunger

- 1. access to safe, nutritious and sufficient food as a human right
- 2. Just Transition for decent job creation in sustainable agriculture
- 3. Decent wages for workers throughout the food system
- 4. skills development to support workers in sustainable agriculture
- 5. Rights for **migrant workers and informal workers** in agriculture and food production
- 6. Avoid financial speculation and extreme food price volatility.
- 7. Land rights for indigenous communities (ILO Convention 169)



#### SDG 13: climate action

- 1. Just transition measures in countries' NDCs
- 2. Social dialogue to promote decent climate-friendly jobs creation
- 3. Rights-based pathways for climate driven migration
- **4. Accelerate decarbonisation** processes (eg. end government subsidies to fossil fuels)
- 5. investment in social protection, skills and lifelong learning
- Step up international climate finance for developing countries
- 7. Provide the finance for the Loss and Damage facility and for investment in just transition



### SDG 16: peaceful societies

#### **Democratic institutions**

- freedom of association / collective bargaining / right to strike
- meaningful participation of social partners in decision-making processes
- End killing kidnapping, enforced disappearance of trade unionists.
- labour courts + access to justice

#### **Peace**

- Disarmament + Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons
- conversion of current investments in weapons into social investments
