A Recap on NDICI-GE

- **One single instrument** for all external funding bringing together all previous 11 instruments
- **Funding €79.46 billion**
- Three components: **geographic, thematic, rapid response**
- **European Fund for Sustainable Development Plus (EFSD+) and External Action Guarantee: 53,4 Billion**
- Specific commitments:
 - 93% ODA
 - 20% for social inclusion and human development;
 - 30% to step up efforts on climate change;
 - 10% management and governance of migration and forced displacement
 - 85% should have gender equality as a principal or significant objective
- References to the Decent Work Agenda, full application of ILO core labour standards, social dialogue, fight against child labour, occupational health and safety, gender equality, living wages, youth employment, social protection and corporate social responsibility).

Commission's priorities for international cooperation

- Partnerships
- Climate change, environment, energy
- Digital and data technologies
- Sustainable growth and jobs
- Migration
- Governance, peace and security, human rights, civil society
- Human development

The Team Europe Approach

- Initially undertaken in response to the COVID-19 crisis
- Aims: coherence and coordination, visibility, EU values and interests
- Bringing together the EU and EUDs with member states (Dev. Agencies + DFIs), EIB and EBRD
- Linked to MIPs at country and regional level
