It is time to act: the world of work is changing and we need to change the rules to ensure social and economic stability, shared prosperity and environmental sustainability. Excesses have been allowed to flourish: multinational corporations are increasingly capturing new technologies and using them to undermine working people's conditions. Women's experience of violence and harassment continues with devastating consequences. People's incomes are increasingly determined, not by the quality or quantity of their work, but by what they can gain from an unfair and unequal economy. Wealth is increasingly being concentrated in the hands of the powerful few.

The Centenary of the International Labor Organization is a once in a generation opportunity to address these issues at the global level. The creation of the ILO and its subsequent Declarations laid the foundations for the Social Contract, with the expansion of democratic principles, and for peace. It is time to heed that legacy. Trade unions are calling on the ongoing Centenary Session of the International Labour Conference to adopt an ambitious Declaration on the future of work with a Universal Labour Guarantee for all working people.


What are we demanding?
