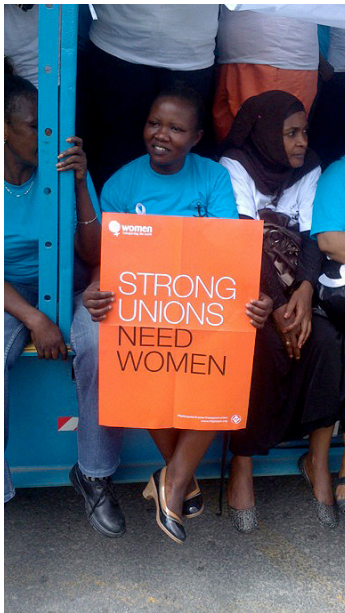




Women Power Unions

We call, therefore, for:

♀ investment in universal access to quality public services, including universal access to essential health care and basic income security to protect the standard of living of the sick, the unemployed, the disabled and the elderly, and those who are unable to work because they are caring for infants or sick family members;

♀ investment in free, equitable, quality education, with no hidden costs, paying particular attention to the most marginalised and vulnerable, who are too often girls and women;

♀ investment in the creation of decent work, including the formalisation of informal jobs, as the most sustainable form of economic empowerment for women.

We represent 70 million women workers from unions all over the world. By standing united, we strengthen women's power and their ability to secure rights and protection at work.
